# Maintaining children's safety and security on premises

#### **Policy statement**

We maintain the highest possible security of our premises to ensure that each child is safely cared for during their time with us.

## Procedures

Children's personal safety

- We ensure enhanced DBS checks have been carried out on all employed staff.
- Adults do not normally supervise children on their own but if so, they are within sight or sound of others.
- All children are supervised by adults at all times.
- Whenever children are on the premises at least two adults are present.
- We carry out risk assessment to ensure children are not made vulnerable within any part of our premises, nor by any activity.

#### Security

- Systems are in place for the safe arrival and departure of children.
- The times of the children's arrivals and departures are recorded should they arrive or leave early.
- The arrival and departure times of adults staff, volunteers, and visitors are recorded.
- Our systems prevent unauthorised access to our premises.
- Our systems prevent children from leaving our premises unnoticed.
- We have CCTV both indoors and outside / large iron gates which are closed when parents & carers have left / we have a walkie talky / the outside area is completely enclosed.
- A password system is in place.
- Visitors are by prior appointment only ensuring all contact details are taken.
- The personal possessions of staff and volunteers are kept safely away from children's reach during sessions.
